However, the Senate recognizes that some items/vendors may change due to pricing, availability, or other unforeseen circumstances and this will be taken into consideration by the Finance Committee and SBA Treasurer when dispersing funds for reimbursement. Unless it has been specified in Section 1 that an item or items may not be purchased within a set allocation of funding, discretion is left up to the Requesting Entity as to how allocated funds will be spent.

Section 3 – Nothing herein shall override any provision of the Student Bar Association Constitution and Bylaws.

Section 4 – Unless otherwise specified herein, this act shall take effect immediately upon passage.






